
Creating Your Own E-books







What is an E-book

- Wikipedia definition
 - A book-length publication in digital form, consisting of text and/or images, readable on computers or other electronic devices
- PDF format does not allow changing font sizes,
 page flow—other formats do
 - Page format is fixed and standard display is 1 page adjusted to fit the screen size available

E-book Readers & Formats


- Amazon Kindle formats
 - AZW, AZW3, PDF, TXT, non-DRM MOBI, PRC
- Barnes & Noble Nook formats
 - EPUB, PDF
- Apple iBooks formats
 - Mac, iPad, iPod, iPhone support EPUB, PDF
 - Mac & iPad support IBA (Multitouch books made via iBooks Author)

Adding PDF/TXT files to Kindle

- Amazon Kindle app on Mac
 - Files stored in Documents/My Kindle Content
 - Drag file to Kindle app
- Amazon Kindle or Kindle app on iPod/iPhone/ iPad via Kindle Cloud
 - Send files to devices using special email address for Kindle Cloud
 - Does not make them accessible from Mac
 - Need to log into Amazon to delete files from Cloud

Adding PDFs/TXTs to Kindle app via iTunes

- Amazon Kindle app on iPod/iPad/iPhone via iTunes
 - Does not put them in Kindle Cloud
 - Does not put them in Kindle Library on Mac
 - Can delete them on the iPod/iPad/iPhone




Kindle app eBook on iPod & MacBook

CHAPTER I. Looking-Glass house






Adding EPUBs & PDFS to iBooks


- Drag to iBooks app
- Use Add to Library... command in File Menu




Syncing iBooks with iTunes

- Offers additional graphics capabilities over Pages and publish as IBA or EPUB in iBooks
- Needs Yosemite/iOS 8 to preview books
- Laridian BookBuilder/BookBuilder Pro (\$19.99/\$49.99)
 - Designed to work with Pocket Bible and offers some unique cross-referencing capabilities for Bible study



Why Create an E-book

- Mac|Life article (May 2015) on Pages capability talks about downloading a text file from Gutenberg (www.gutenberg.org) into Pages and formatting it with pictures
 - Gutenberg already offers EPUB format
- Set up text for a talk that will be easily read from an iPad/iPod/iPhone
 - Questions to ask your doctor?
- Create an E-Book describing a vacation trip with pictures & videos








BookBuilder Pro Capabilities



- Much more difficult to use than iBooks Author
- Consists of multiple tools
 - DocAnalyzer
 - VerseLinker
 - BookBuilder
- Requires use of a basic text editor to create HTML files
 - TextWrangler by Bare Bones Software (free)
 www.barebones.com
- Comes with sample files

Book Builder Pro Help



Using BookBuilder

- Use a plain-text editor, not a word processor
 - Need to create 7-bit ASCII files
 - Fancy characters like emdash (—) need to be entered as —
- Use DocAnalizer to find illegal characters
- Insert required HTML codes to define paragraphs, etc.
- Use VerseLinker if you want to create links to Bible references
- Run BookBuilder to create the .lbk file that can be read using PocketBible
- Use iTunes to copy the .lbk file to your iPod/iPad

HTML Body Tags

- Paragraphs defined by
- Heading tags generate Table of Contents
 - <h1> </h1>, <h2> </h2>, <h3> </h3>, ..., <h9> </h9>
 - Regular HTML only supports 6 levels
- Bold and italic specified via HTML
 - , <i> </i>
- Only bitmap (.bmp) images are supported
- BookBuilder recognizes link tags for Bible verses (not standard HTML)
 - <pb_link format=bcv>Romans 12:1</pb_link>
- Other BookBuilder HTML tags needed to support Greek and Spanish languages




