

Applying for a Library Card

Physical library cards are not being issued at this time. If you live in the County of Los Angeles, you can get immediate access to our digital collections through an e-card.

e-Cards

Residents of Los Angeles can get an e-Card by registering online. An e-Card provides access to online databases and downloadable e-media. It may not be used to place holds on regular library items, nor is it valid for the computer reservation system. Patrons who already have a regular library card do not need an e-Card.

- Make sure you are using your library card number (starting with "272..." with no dashes or spaces) and PIN, the last four digits of the telephone number in your account. It might be an older telephone number than you expect.
