Did you know?

- If you live in California, LAPL is one of your libraries. Your tax money supports it.



Did you know?

- ▶ LAPL fully supports all Apple devices through its membership in a universal availability system.



LAPL's catalog is impressive

- ▶ State and local funding
- ▶ Experienced collection management
- ▶ Support for a diverse population
- ▶ If it exists, both an ebook and audio version of a book is usually available



LAPL is patron-sensitive

- ▶ Quick to acquire new releases
- ▶ As wait lists grow, more copies are available, within reason
- ▶ A title you recommend automatically puts you in the “holds list” when the title is available



Borrowing privileges are generous!

- ▶ Checkout limit: 30 titles
- ▶ Titles on hold limit: 20
- ▶ Borrowing period: 21 days
- ▶ Renewals are available
- ▶ Never an overdue penalty!

Applying for a Library Card

Physical library cards are not being issued at this time. If you live in the County of Los Angeles, you can get immediate access to our digital collections through an e-card. ★

e-Cards

Residents of Los Angeles can get an e-Card by registering online. An e-Card provides access to online databases and downloadable e-media. It may not be used to place holds on regular library items, nor is it valid for the computer reservation system. Patrons who already have a regular library card do not need an e-Card.

Having trouble using your Library Card online? Try these tips!

- ▶ Make sure you are accessing our digital items either through our website (lapl.org) or using our name, Los Angeles Public Library, in the e-media app. Our name is very similar to the Los Angeles County Public Library, so many people make that mistake.
- ▶ Make sure you are using your library card number (starting with "272..." with no dashes or spaces) and PIN, the last four digits of the telephone number in your account. It might be an older telephone number than you expect.

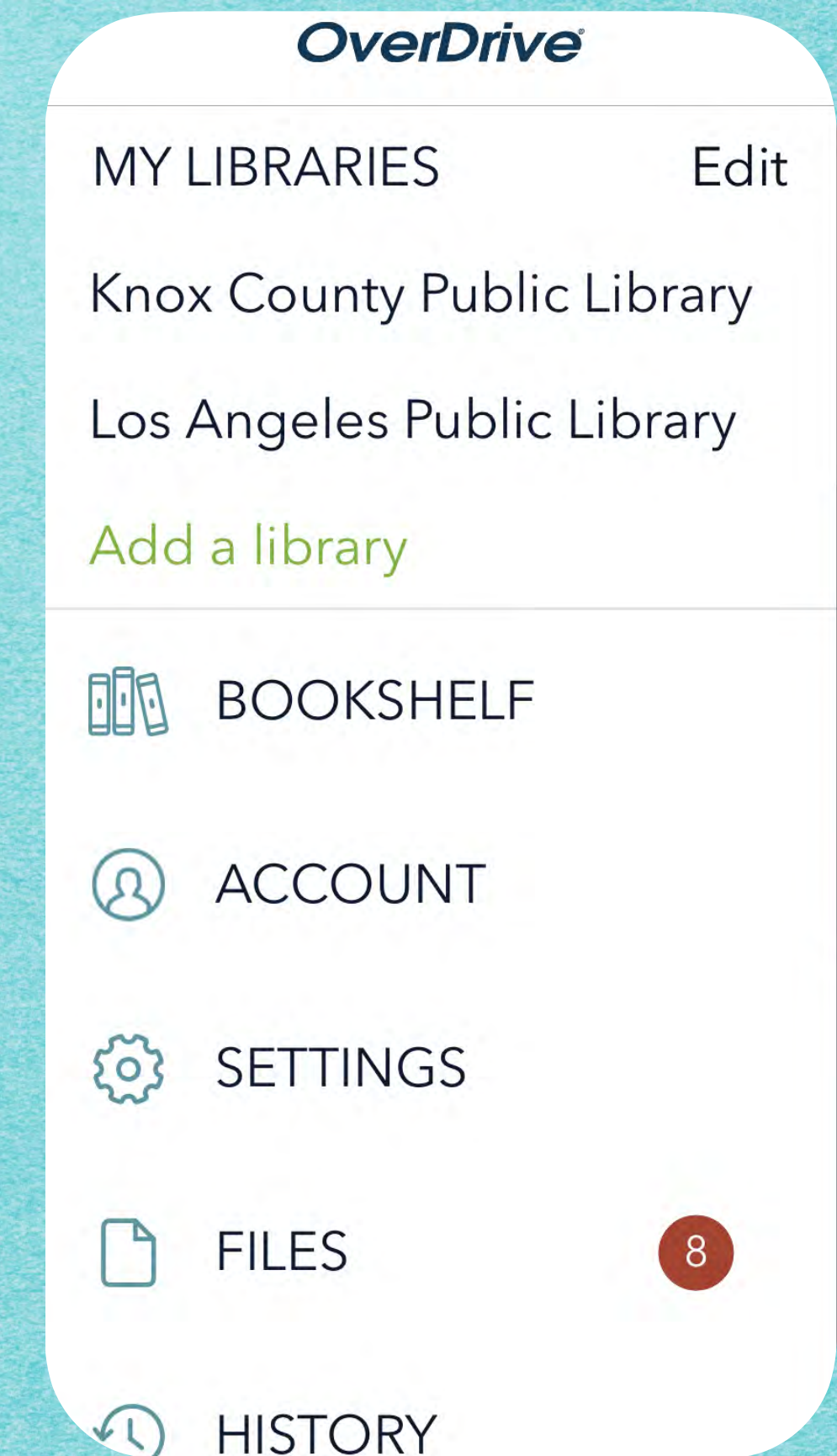
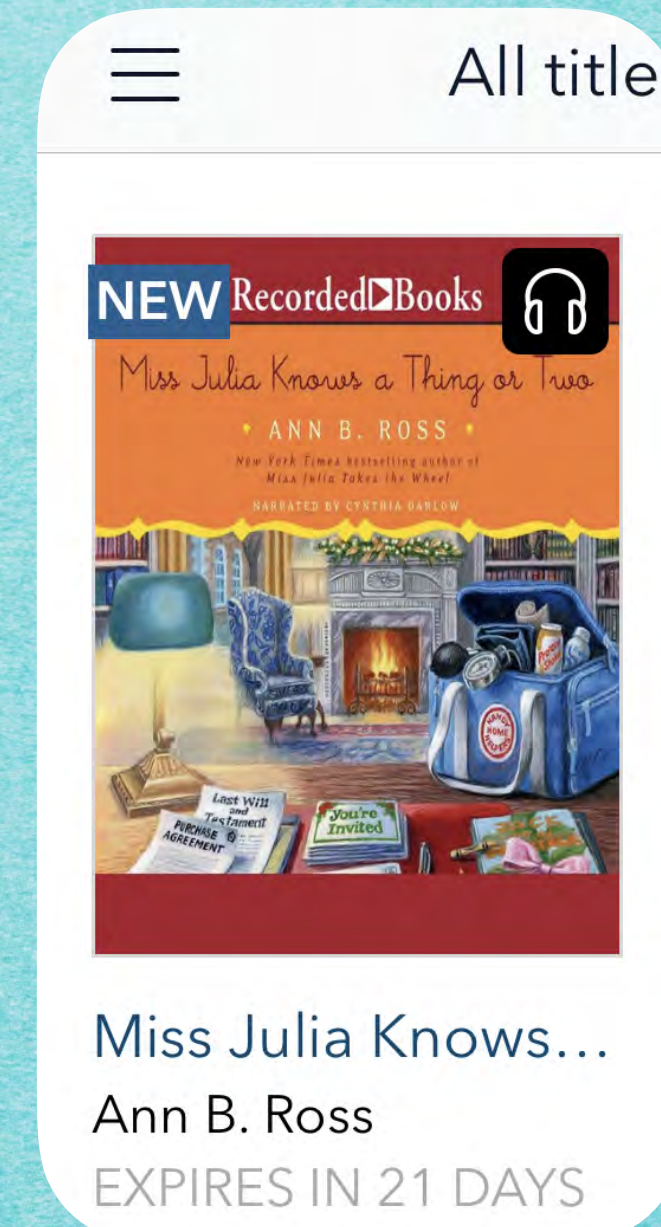
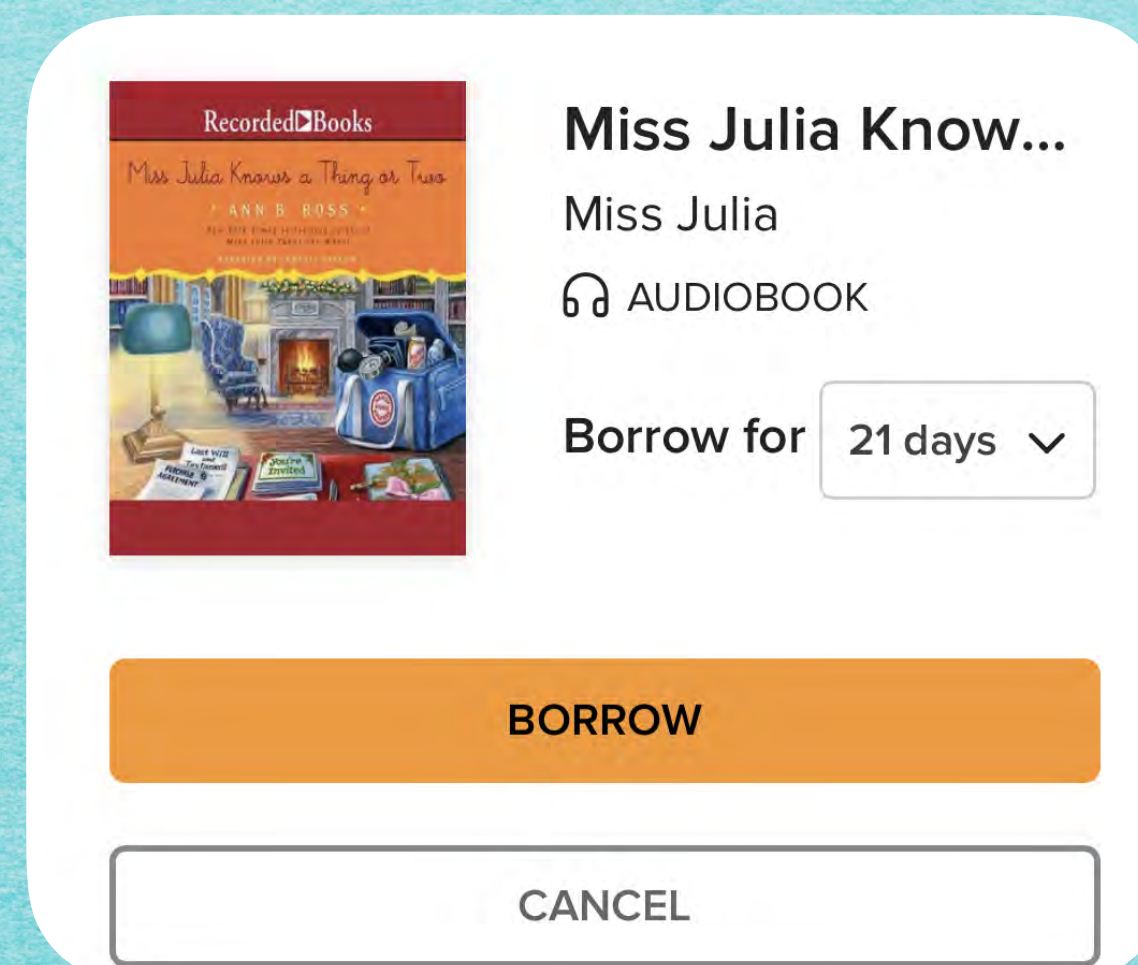
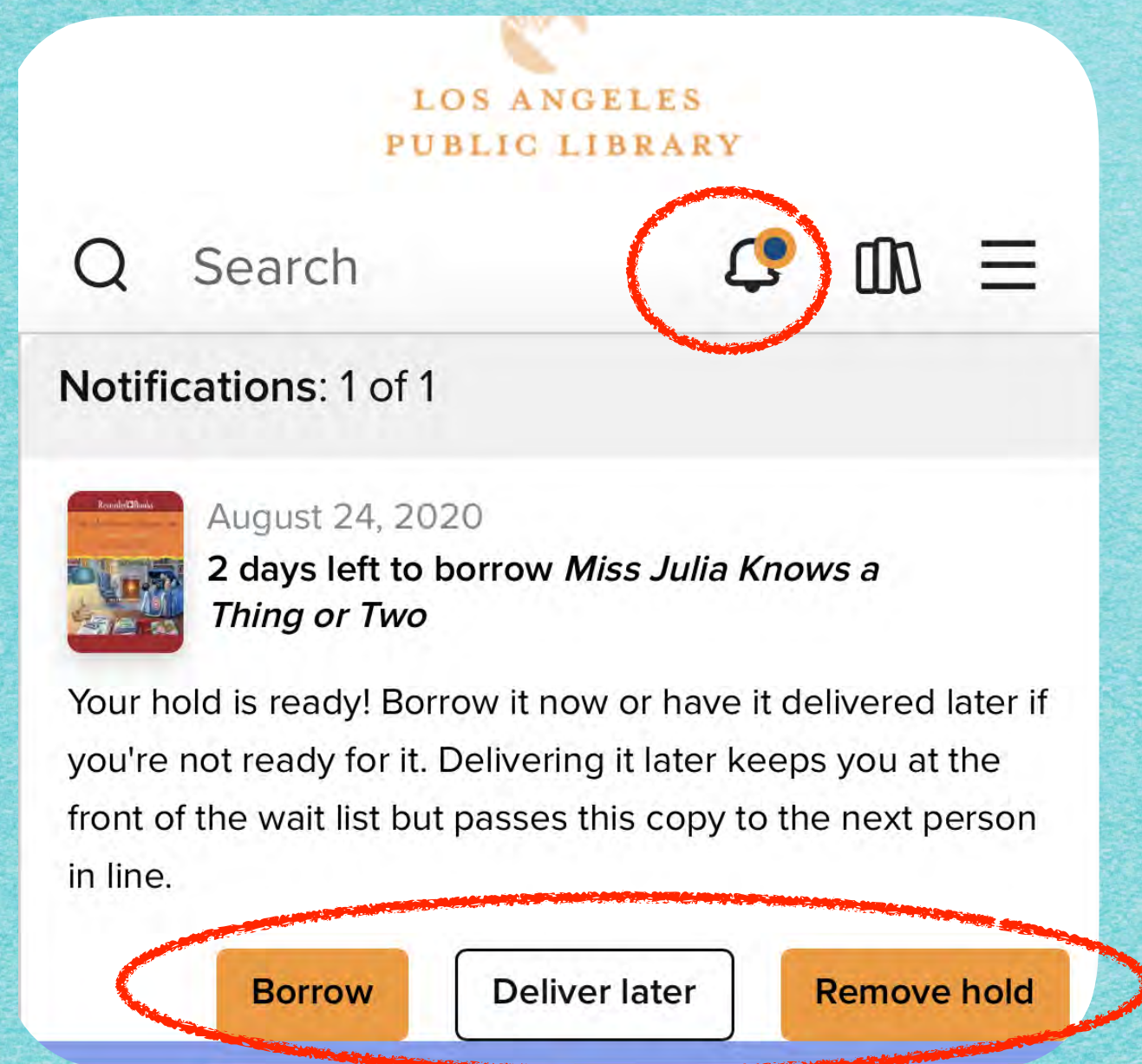


**Renewals are easy; from the LOANS link on the LAPL page
