Why Use iMazing 2 App?

- You want to easily backup your IOS devices on a routine basis to your Mac or an external drive
- iTunes on the Mac previously backed up IOS devices on the Mac, pre 2020
- iMazing enables access to backups that iTunes stored on your Mac
- You want to easily transfer files, photos, messages, attachments to your Mac for printing or storage (You may transfer from the Mac to the IOS device as well)
- You want to easily browse your iPhone photo collection that resides in your iMazing backup on your Mac.

More About iMazing 2

- Software download: Free Trial has limitations on number of files you may xfr
- Software License: activates full set of features for lifetime of IOS version, then access to backup file ends until you renew the license
- iPods, iPhones, and iPads are supported, either via USB cable or Wi-Fi

Backing Up Your Mac

- Most users are comfortable with local backups on aTime Machine external drive, plus a Bootable Backup external drive, using Carbon Copy Cloner CCC
- Beware whether Mac- OS-dependent SuperDuper! bugs have been fixed if you plan to use that backup utility
- Starting with High Sierra on the Mac, the Apple File System, APFS, is used.
 Be sure to read the CCC documentation before you format your external backup drive for CCC
- To protect against loss by fire or theft, an offsite Backup is needed. A cloudbased backup service, e.g BackBlaze, is ideal since it can be updated daily
- Some users store one of two two backup hard drives in a safe place outside of their residence, such as another family-member's residence, swapped monthly, or as needed
