Alphabetize

- Can't find what you're looking for
- View --> Alphabetical
- Or click on the 9-dot icon

Search

- WiFi
- Two places - good for looking for buried items

Accessibility

My friends with disabilities call me "currently-abled"

Three-finger Drag

- You probably know how to tap instead of click
 - Trackpad --> Point/Click --> Tap to click
- But I hate clicking so much, I don't want to click to drag windows around
 - Accessibility
 - Pointer control
 - Trackpad Options
 - Checkbox for Enable Dragging
 - Dropdown to three fingered drag

Now by simply gently resting three fingers on the top of a window you can drag the window around without clicking.

Zoom in Temporarily

- During presentations (like this) or just because something is too small
- Take maps for example - zoom in, still can't read them
- Zoom → use control gesture with modifier keys to zoom → default is control key
 - zoom style - full screen
- demo zoom on maps
 - change to pic-in-pic
 - change to split screen

Dock & Menu Bar

Redundantly-named Dock & Menu Bar tab

- Uncheck auto hide/show menu bar
- open 3 Safari windows
- You could hide each one with yellow dot, or hold option key and all are in dock separately
- Open them back up
- Checkbox "min windows to app icon"
- Hide again - watch swoosh into dock app icon
- Now click app icon - see all three

Control Center

- Show Default control center - two switches
- Every control will always show in control center
 - This lets you show them ALSO in menu bar
 - I like to see WiFi symbol
 - Also Sound
- 3 modules you can add not on by default
- 4 Menu bar only

- Can control look of clock but not remove

General

Scroll Bars

- I hate that windows don't show scroll bars
- Show always

Handoff

- Lets you copy on your phone or iPad and paste into Mac or vice versa
- Continuity be awesome
- All devices have to be logged into same iCloud account
- Add iPhone to Zoom (blow their minds?)
- iPhone: Swipe down in Settings to search Handoff
- Settings → General → AirPlay & Handoff → toggle Handoff
- Type in CotEditor
- Paste into Notes (dumb example)

Keyboard

Text (Replacements)

- Poor woman's TextExpander - **works across iOS**
- Open Notes
- Plus button
 - Replace ,sba with SBAMUG
 - Now in Notes type ,sba
- Correct spelling, Capitalize words, add period with double-space

Shortcuts

- Keyboard shortcuts for Apple functionality
- Have trouble remembering screenshot shortcuts?
- You can also add your own - must be typed EXACTLY
 - Safari View->Hide Tab Bar
 - Add control-option-shift-command-B
 - Same for Show Tab Bar

Input sources

- Have trouble finding emoji?
- Show input in menu bar
- Show emoji & symbols in menu bar
- Cool, now click button in upper right
 - Character viewer
 - Emoji PLUS arrows, bullets, math symbols
 - Search for Smrik
 - Add to favorites
 - Double click to paste into Notes

Network

- Ever have WiFi take when you're on wired Ethernet?
 - Gear under list of network interfaces - set service order by dragging
 - Thunderbolt Ethernet to top
 - Hit Apply
- Have a network your Mac keeps joining (maybe your own guest network?)
 - Advanced
 - See WD Guest above WD?
 - First can shut off Auto join
 - Also can drag up and down
 - Don't forget Apply

Type to Siri

- Feel silly talking to computer?
- Siri Preference pane - no option to type
- Use search to find it
 - Search for Type to

- Finds in Accessibility
- Use back arrow in Prefs to get to Siri prefs
 - Default shortcut is "hold command space" - too hard
 - Change to function-space
 - function-space, type turn *on* dark mode
 - function-space, type turn *off* dark mode
