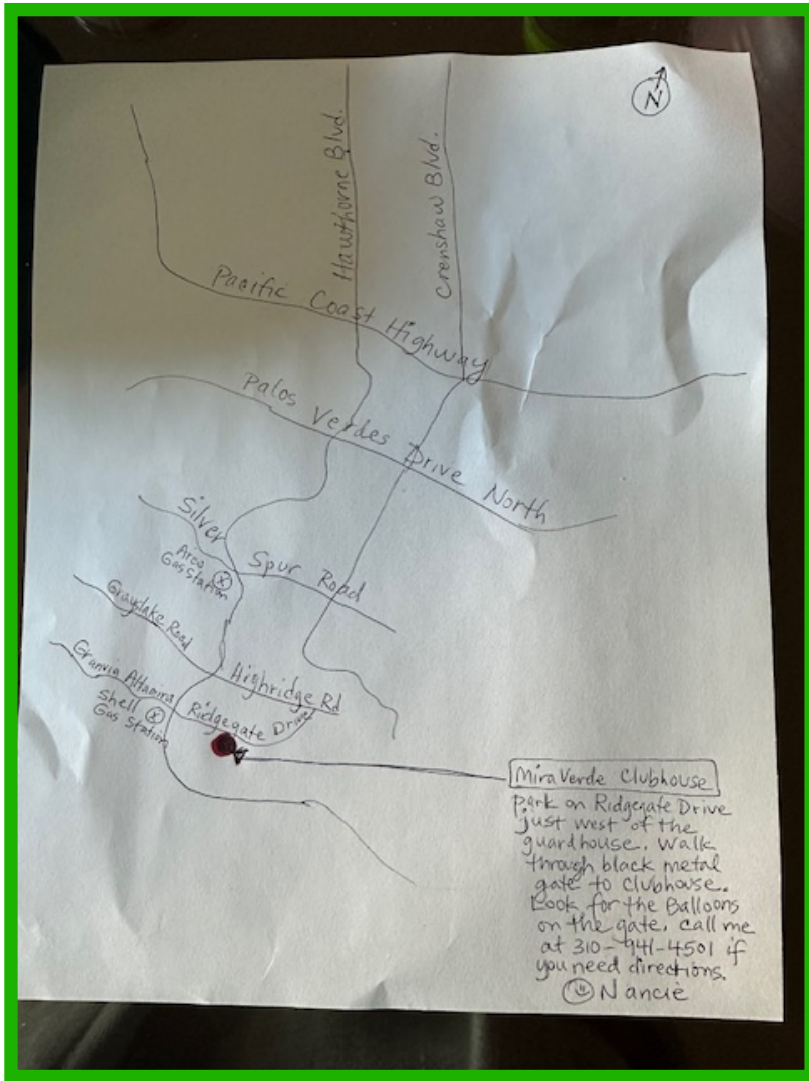
On Friday, December 1, a BALLOT for the election of SBAMUG Slate of Officers was sent by email to everybodysbamug.com.

MAPS to the Wednesday, December 13 Meeting/Pizza Party



Hand-drawn Map to the left - If you are NOT familiar with the Palos Verdes Peninsula, check out the hand-drawn map to the left. If you are north or east of Palos Verdes, take Hawthorne Blvd. south and pass Pacific Coast Highway, then Palos Verdes Drive West, then Silver Spur. Keep heading south on Hawthorne and turn LEFT at RIDGEGATE Drive. See map below for details of where to park and location of MiraVerde Clubhouse on Ridgeway Drive.



Detailed Map to the right - Once you get to the corner of Hawthorne Blvd. and Ridgeway Drive, here's what to do. If you are heading SOUTH on Hawthorne Blvd., turn left on Ridgeway Drive. If you are heading NORTH on Hawthorne Blvd., turn RIGHT on Ridgeway Drive. Go about a block up the street and you will see two Guardhouses, one on each side of the street. Go past the guard house on the right, and park anywhere the curb is not red. To the right will be a pool, and a small basketball court. Go through the black metal gate and straight to the Clubhouse. I will put balloons on the gate so you can find it. I will also be on the street to direct you. Parking is FREE on the street. **If you need more specific directions, please call me at 310-941-4501.** (Note: There are two HOAs on Ridgeway Drive — MiraVerde HOA & Ridgeway HOA. *Be sure to go to MiraVerde.*)
